At the corner of Montrepose and West Chestnut stands the former Ulster Academy , a public school, and later to become the Number 2 School, an elementary school. With 900 students, Ulster Academy was once Ulster County's largest school. Built in 1870, it had a library of 1,500 volumes that could be borrowed by local residents. The building was the temporary first home of Ulster County Community College. The building has been turned into several condominiums, each of which comes with a blackboard.
